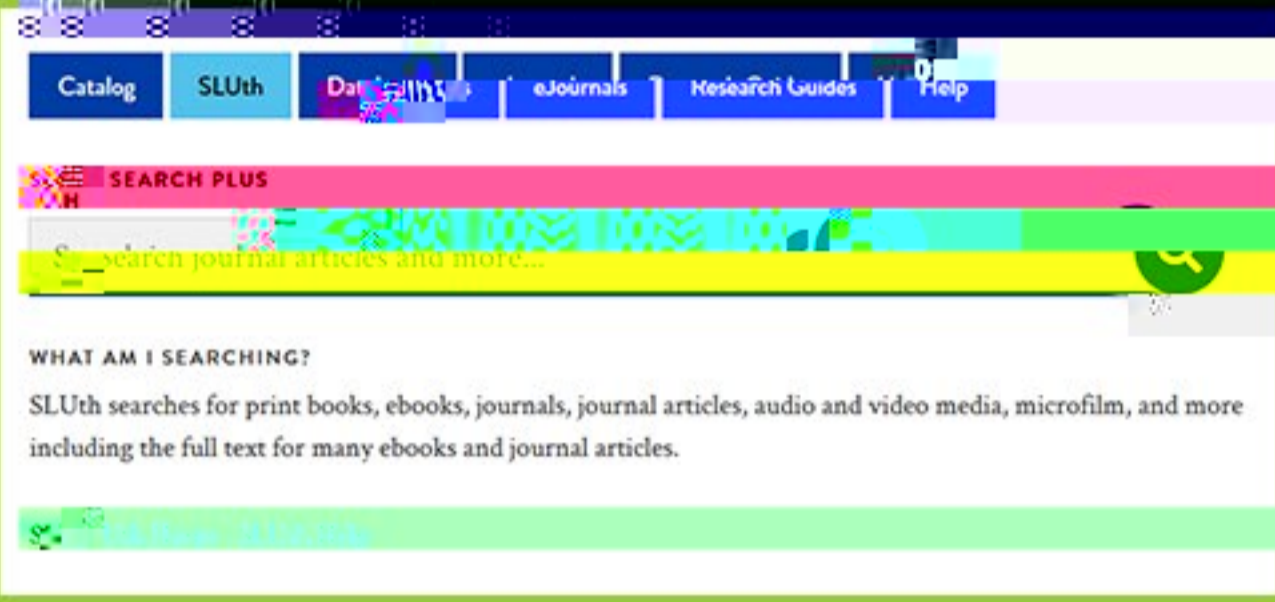


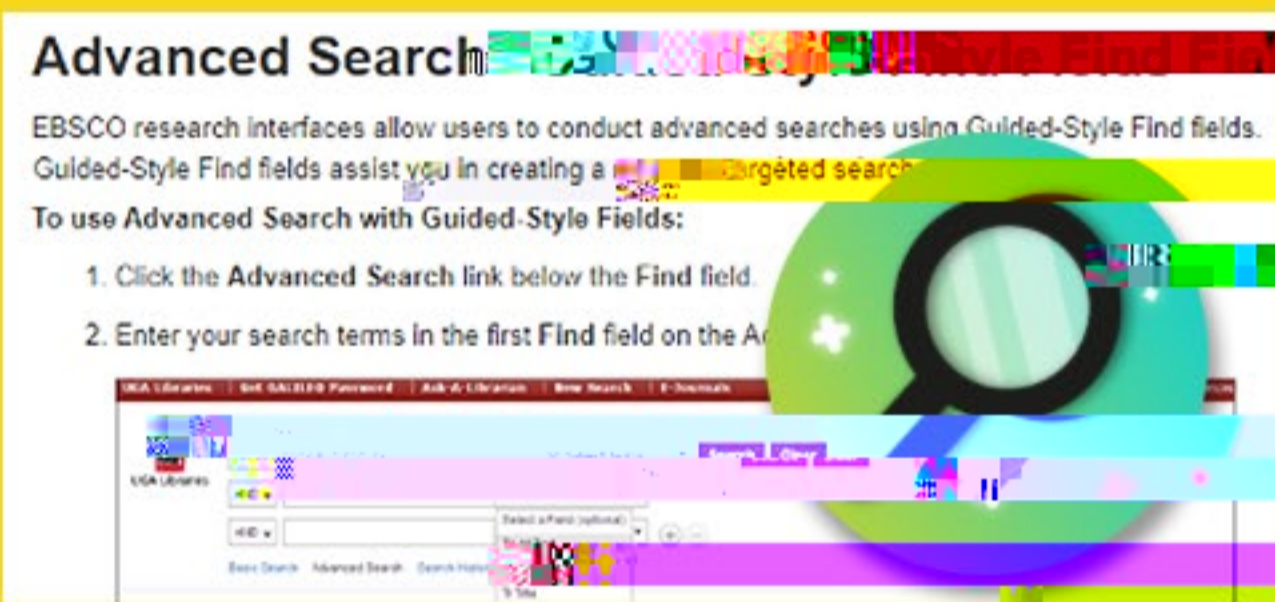
Library Instruction Sessions
