They were aked about additional apport students may need to acceed in this program. Dr. Zustiak indicated that students who d not have the necessary background to complete the coursework in the pograms would typically be asked to complete that coursework prior to applying to and beginning the program.

The committee discussion including a number of areas of darification to request from BME for the two programs including questions discussed with the faculty submitting the proposal.

For both, there is need for a revision of the section on good standing to darify the requirements for good standing and the steps that would allow students to return to good standing with regard to performance to coursework.

There was als a reed for clarification on program requirements regarding time and their fit with university time-to-degree equirements. What do those time requirements mean for part-time students (f they are allowed to be part-time)?

For the M.S.the curricular requirements sould dearly separate the thesis ad non-thesis requirements.

For the Ph.D., admission requirements ed to be consistent throughout proposal.

In non-course equirements, the description of the qualifying examination (required exams, their timing, structure, and process) eachs to be revised and arified. It isn't clear what is required. The dissertation should be ferenced directly.

Questions will be sent back to he programs por to a vote.
